

Coach/Asst. Coach - Code of Conduct

If coaches, players or spectators intimidate game officials and violate game rules, this will result in either a technical foul or a game forfeiture.

Referees have the authority to monitor and discipline **any individual** within a gym facility during the game.

The decision of game officials is final in all cases.

Coaches

- Know, teach and follow the rules of basketball as defined by the BPAA basketball league.
- Recognize and appreciate a good play, no matter who makes it.
- Teach and encourage good sportsmanship.
- Avoid improper gestures and language.
- Treat opponents, players, parents and officials with respect.
- Accept the decisions of officials as final say.
- Avoid public displays of criticism in front of players and spectators.
- Exercise self-control at all times. This sets the example for others to follow.
- Respect the property of others.

Failure to abide by the Code could result in consequences including technical fouls, forfeiture of a game and the termination of coaching abilities for the duration of up to one year.
